“One week without plastic“ by Mission EineWelt

The subject

Plastic waste poses a massive threat to the living environment of animals and plants and ultimately to us humans as well. Germany produces about 3 million tons of plastic waste every year, of which more than a quarter is exported - mainly to countries in the Global South. This makes Germany one of the world's largest exporters of plastic waste after Japan and the USA.

Politics, the economy and society are called upon to change this. But how does that work in everyday life? - Is a life without plastic even possible? It's about trying to make it possible. This is why Mission EineWelt challenges you to reduce the consumption of plastic for one week in March 2022 as much as possible in the campaign “Creation - Not for Sale!”.

Shopping with a cotton bag, reusable fruit, vegetable or bread bags instead of plastic-wrapped food, selfmade cosmetic products stored in a glass container, tap water instead of water from plastic bottles ... these are first ideas to avoid plastic waste. However, there is more that can be done for sure!

Perhaps at the end of the experiment we will see more clearly if and how a life without plastic could work. Where renunciation is easy and where it is difficult or maybe even impossible?

We are curious to see what you will find out about plastic fasting. We would like to get a clearer picture of this in the truest sense of the word. Hence our request: Document your experiences and adventures with pictures and take part in our photo competition for the “One week without plastic“ campaign. The three best campaign photos will be awarded cash prizes of 500 euros (1st place), 200 euros (2nd place) and 100 euros (3rd place).

The task

Take pictures on the topic of “One week without plastic!“. Images that document the excessive consumption of plastic and its consequences (worldwide) and/or images that tell of the many ways how to avoid plastic. Present your ideas for plastic fasting!

The key data

The photo competition starts on **March 13, 2022** and runs until **June 19, 2022**.

Participation is for individuals.

- One to three photos per participant can be submitted. For evaluation we need digital files in one of the following image formats .jpg, .gif, .bmp, .tiff, .png. The resolution must be at least 300 dpi. One picture should not exceed a file size of 5 MB.
- When submitting the photos, the following informations must be included: date and location of the photo, brief description of the photo content and your reference to the topic „One week without plastic“ (max. 500 characters), as well as, first and last name, address, telephone number and e-mail address of the photographer. - Participants must own the copyright of the photo(s). If the submitted photos show recognizable people, the participants have to confirm their consent in writing. <https://keine-ware.de/eine-woche-ohne-plastik/fotowettbewerb/>
- These persons agree to give Mission EineWelt the rights for publication in print, internet, social media, press work and exhibitions free of charge. The name of the photographer will be mentioned.

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Conditions of participation for the photo competition “One week without plastic”

1. Participation is open to all interested persons worldwide. In the case of underage participants, a declaration of consent of the guardians must also be submitted. A template can be downloaded from <https://keine-ware.de/eine-woche-ohne-plastik/fotowettbewerb/>.
2. One to max. three photos per participant can be submitted together with the following information: date and location of the photo, a brief description of the photo contents and their reference to the subject “A week without plastic” (max. 500 characters) as well as the first and last name, address, telephone number and e-mail address of the photographer. Similarly, for identifiable persons on the photo (s), a corresponding declaration of consent of the person (s) must be submitted (a template can be downloaded from the website above). The submission of the photo(s) must be in one of the usual image formats: jpg, . jpeg, . gif, . tiff, png, max. gile size/image: 5 MB and resolution min. 300 dpi.
3. Incomplete application documents will not take part in the contest.

5. Deadline for submissions is June 19, 2022
6. Participation is free of charge. Participants will not be reimbursed for expenses.
7. The selection of the winning photos is made by a jury consisting of employees of Mission EineWelt and representatives of the press and photography.
8. The photos uploaded for the photo contest may be used and published free of charge by MEW in the context of public relations for the photo contest and for information and advertising purposes in digital and print media, naming the author. To this end, the participant transfers to the Center MEW the right of publication, use and reproduction. A fee claim does not result from this. Any further use beyond that, in particular any use or reuse by third parties, requires the express consent of the participant.
9. The participant guarantees that he/she has all rights to the submitted picture, that he/she has unrestricted rights of exploitation of all parts of the picture, that the picture is free of third party rights and that no personal rights are infringed when depicting persons. In the case of persons, works, marks or other objects depicted therein, the participants have obtained the necessary consent in writing from the persons concerned or rightholders. Should third parties nevertheless assert claims for infringement of their rights, the participant shall indemnify the organizer Mission EineWelt from all claims.
10. The following prizes are awarded for the winning photos:
1st prize: 500.- Euro
2nd prize: 200.- Euro
3rd prize: 100.- Euro
Payment will be made to an account to be designated by the participants.
11. Mission EineWelt reserves the right to exclude participants from the contest in case of violation of the conditions of participation. In addition, participants who use unauthorized means or who otherwise wish to gain an advantage through manipulation or false personal information will be excluded from participation.
12. The winner is responsible for any taxation of the winnings.
13. Employees of Mission EineWelt are excluded from participating in the photo contest.
14. Mission One World reserves the right to postpone, cancel or terminate the contest at any time without notice and without giving reasons.
Mission EineWelt makes use of this option in particular if, for technical reasons (e. g. viruses in the computer system or manipulation) or for legal reasons, the proper execution of the action cannot be guaranteed. If such termination is caused by the conduct of a participant, Mission EineWelt may require that person to compensate for the damage incurred.
